

This is the third year that we have awarded the scholarship which provides \$ 2,000.00 each year to a candidate reflecting high achievement in environmental pursuits. The award is a reflection of the high regard that friends, colleagues and business associates held for Bob Caton and we are pleased that his work on behalf of the environment and in support of students can be remembered by the annual award of a scholarship in his name. Bob was a tireless supporter of environmental improvement and conducted his work with lofty goals and unshakeable integrity. Bob worked at the highest technical level on air quality and health issues but also contributed significantly in the areas of environmental management and policy.
